Biography

David Lebrun has worked as a professional photographer and videographer for businesses — portraits, events, conferences — since 2011. Living from his passion is a satisfaction he savours every day. This freedom has allowed him to bring Art into his life as a commercial photographer, like a furtive glance through the fences of a construction site not yet completed.

Artistic Approach

I love to communicate, to talk, to feel. Portrait photography is one of my favourite pursuits. I love photographing human beings in their non-verbal communication.

During my many travels, I try to provoke opportunities to photograph landscapes, which I often render in contrasted black and white — often at sea, often in the mountains.

Fine art photography is far removed from the corporate world of conferences and events, but this artistic parenthesis is a breath of fresh air that is indispensable to my practice as a photographer.

David Lebrun wins the Gold Medal at the Salon des Artistes Français 2026 — Grand Palais, Paris

Photographer David Lebrun, based in Le Perreux-sur-Marne, received the Gold Medal this week under the nave of the Grand Palais as part of ART CAPITAL. His award-winning photograph depicts a sailboat under spinnaker, its wind-filled sail evoking the movement of a dress in full dance — a black and white work in which the sea becomes poetic matter.

A member of the Société des Artistes Français since 2015 and a regular exhibitor since 2013, David Lebrun has already been recognised with numerous prizes and medals, including the Assemblée Nationale Medal in 2025. His artistic practice, shaped by travel, contrasted landscapes and maritime scenes, sits between power, elegance and movement.

The medal-winning work was presented to **43,000 visitors** at ART CAPITAL — Salon des Artistes Français 2026, at the Grand Palais in Paris.

Notable: David Lebrun joins a very select group of photographers from Le Perreux-sur-Marne to be medalled by the Société des Artistes Français — the only other being Eric Drigny, Gold Medal in 2025.

PAYSAGES

Contrasted black and white landscapes, captured at sea and in the mountains — shaped by light, wind, and solitude.



MARINES

Sailing, regattas, and open water — the sea as a field of motion and light, from solitary crossings to the intensity of the race.



HUMANS

Portraits and nudes exploring the human body as a language — communication beyond words.

Where photography meets painting, poetry, and music — a visual language born from other art forms.
